

Pankaj Jandwani, MD, MMM

Dr. Pankaj Jandwani is Regional Vice President for Medical Affairs and Chief Innovation Officer for MyMichigan Health. Before assuming this role in August 2018, he served as Chief Medical Information Officer for the health system.

Pankaj graduated in 1995 from Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi, India, before completing his residency in Internal Medicine at Michigan State University and a master's degree in medical management (MMM) from Carnegie Mellon University. He is board-certified in Internal Medicine, Clinical Informatics and Healthcare Quality Assurance and Utilization Review.

Pankaj practiced internal medicine in his private practice for 15 years in various clinical settings, including ambulatory, emergency, hospital medicine and skilled nursing facilities before joining MyMichigan Medical Group. Pankaj first started in his leadership role in 2004 as the medical director for Hospital Medicine and Inpatient Rehab Program and has since served in many leadership roles including VPMA for post-acute care and CMIO. He led several health system initiatives including several EMR conversions, technology optimization programs to address physician burnout, and the implementation of foundational elements for the health system's telemedicine program.

As the Regional VPMA, Pankaj oversees VPMAs & medical staff for four of the seven medical centers at MyMichigan Health. He also leads the health system's Innovation & Transformation program focused on reducing variation in healthcare processes, performance improvement, and advancing digital tools, including predictive analytics & virtual healthcare. Most recently, he has led the development of a comprehensive Hospital at Home program. MyMichigan Medical Center Midland was one of the first 100 hospitals in the country and amongst the first five in Michigan to receive a Waiver from CMS for Hospital at Home care for Medicare beneficiaries.
